### WHAT DOES American Enterprise Bank DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

<b>Why?</b>	<p>Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.</p> <p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p>
<b>What?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social Security number and income</li> <li>• Account balance and payment history</li> <li>• Credit history and credit score</li> </ul> <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
<b>How?</b>	<p>All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons American Enterprise Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.</p>

<b>What We Do</b>	
How does American Enterprise Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does American Enterprise Bank collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Open an account or deposit money</li> <li>• Pay your bills or apply for a loan</li> <li>• Use your debit card</li> </ul> <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- *Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness*
- *Affiliates from using your information to market to you*
- *Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you*

## Definitions

### Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Our affiliate is American Enterprise Insurance Company.*

### Non-affiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *American Enterprise Bank does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.*

### Joint Marketing

A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *American Enterprise Bank does not jointly market.*

## Other Important Information

Illinois law requires that you opt-in to information sharing. Therefore, before we would share your information with a third party, except where permitted by law, we will obtain your permission.
