What We Do		
How does Badger Globe Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.

Affiliates	<ul> <li>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.</li> <li>Badger Globe Credit Union does not share with our affiliates.</li> </ul>	
Nonaffiliates	<ul> <li>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.</li> <li>Nonaffiliates we share with can include insurance companies.</li> </ul>	
Joint Marketing	<ul> <li>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</li> <li>Badger Globe Credit Union doesn't jointly market.</li> </ul>

For Alaska, Illinois, Maryland and North Dakota Members. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization.

**For California Members.** We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization. We will also limit our sharing of personal information about you with our affiliates to comply with all California privacy laws that apply to us.

For Massachusetts, Mississippi and New Jersey Members. We will not share personal information from deposit or share relationships with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization.

**For Vermont Members.** We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates for them to market to you without your authorization and we will not share personal information with affiliates or for joint marketing about your creditworthiness without your authorization.
