FACTS	What does Bank of Quincy do with your personal information?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number and income • Account balances and payment history • Credit history and credit scores <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Bank of Quincy chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Bank of Quincy protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information, and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.
How does Bank of Quincy collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open an account or deposit money • Pay your bills or apply for a loan • Use your credit or debit card We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes— information about your creditworthiness • affiliates from using your information to market to you • sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Our affiliates include companies with a common corporate identity of Bank of Quincy; financial companies such as HOMEBANK, Home Bank of California, Byron B. Webb, Inc., Quincy Bancshares Inc., Lajolla Fund LLC, and others, such as The Webb Co. LLC</i>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Bank of Quincy does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Bank of Quincy does not jointly market.</i>

We restrict access to information about you to those employees who need to know that information to provide products or services to you. 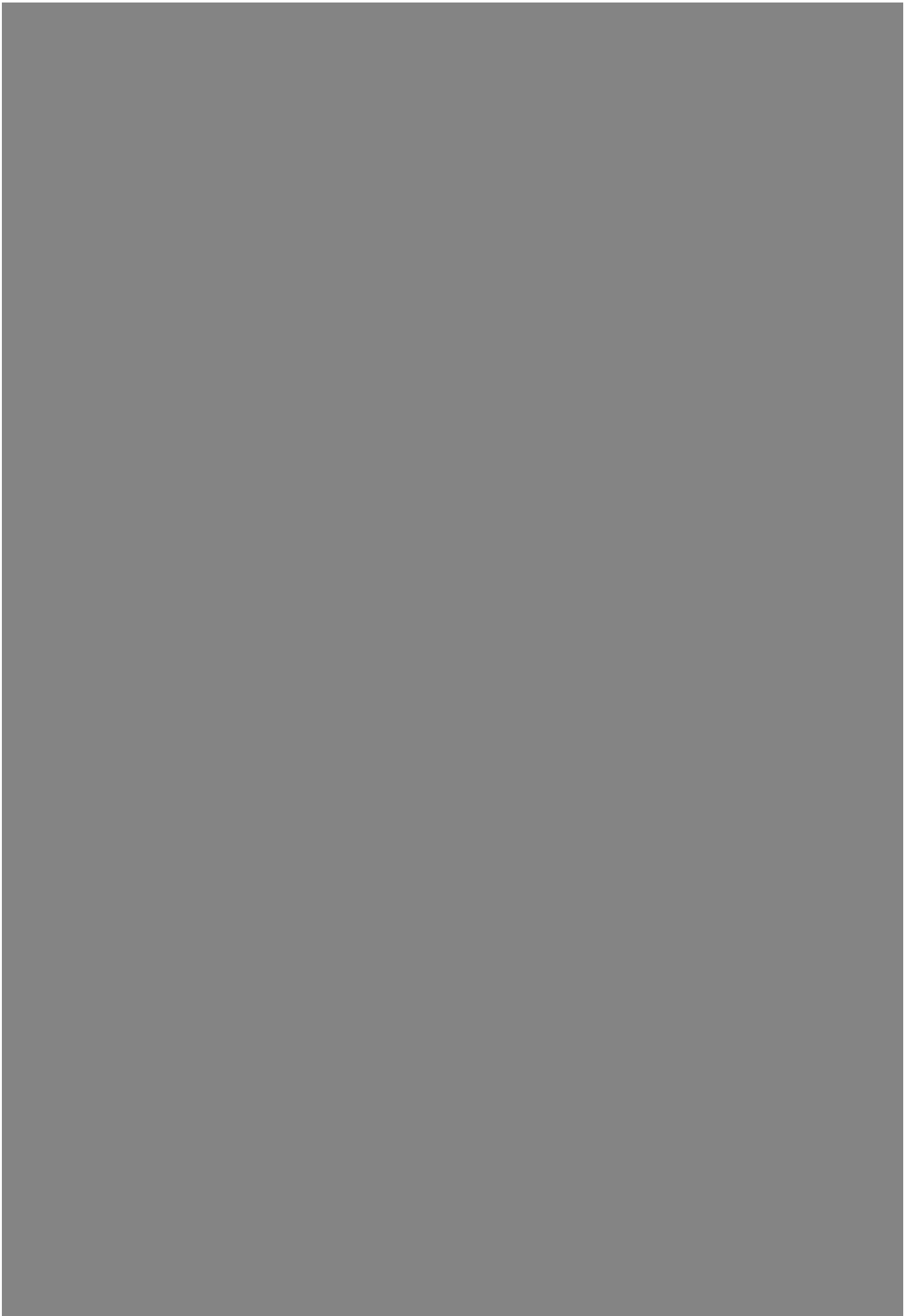
Bank of Quincy; Notice of changes in temporary FDIC insurance coverage for transaction accounts: By operation of federal law, beginning January 1, 2013, funds deposited in a noninterest-bearing transaction account (including an Interest on Lawyer Trust Account) no longer will receive unlimited deposit insurance coverage by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC). Beginning January 1, 2013, all of a depositor's accounts at an insured depository institution, including all noninterest-bearing transaction accounts, will be insured by the FDIC up to the standard maximum deposit insurance amount (\$250,000), for each deposit insurance ownership category.
