



FACTS WHAT DOES BANKWEST OF KANSAS DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why? Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What? The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and Income
- Account Balances and Payment History
- Transaction History and Credit History

How? All financial companies need to share customer's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customer's personal information; the reasons BANKWEST OF KANSAS chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

<p>Why can't I limit all sharing?</p>	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes-information about your creditworthiness ■ affiliates from using your information to market to you ■ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you
<p>What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?</p>	<p>Your choice will apply to everyone on your account - unless you tell us otherwise.</p>

Definitions

<p>Affiliates</p>	<p><i>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>BANKWEST OF KANSAS has no affiliates</i>
<p>Nonaffiliates</p>	<p><i>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Non affiliates that we share with can include service providers, data processors, credit analysis systems and credit reporting agencies.</i>
<p>Joint Marketing</p>	<p><i>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Our joint marketing partners include Intuit Financial Services</i>
