WHAT DOES BASIN STATE BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number
- Payment history
- Credit history

- Overdraft history
- Checking account information
- Wire transfer instructions

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information, the reasons Basin State Bank chooses to share, and whether you can limit this sharing.

What We Do		
How does Basin State Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.	
How does Basin State Bank collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account Apply for a loan Use your credit or debit card We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law give you the right to limit only • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your credithworthiness • affiliates from using your information to market to you • affiliates from using your information to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing
