Definitions				
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  Courthouse Title & Escrow LLC (CTE) is an affiliated company of the bank. CTE provides real estate closings and title services. Information is only shared with CTE with customer's consent.			
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  Citizens National Bank does use nonaffiliates (third parties) to provide banking products and services useful to you. See below for more information.			
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  Citizens National Bank does not jointly market.
