WHAT DOES CITY OF RALEIGH ECU DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Social Security number ● Account balances ● Payment history ● Transaction or loss history ● Credit history ● Account transactions
How?	All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons City of Raleigh ECU chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Reasons we can share your personal information	Does City of Raleigh ECU share?	Can you limit this sharing?
For our everyday business purposes - such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

For our affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your transactions and experiences	No	We don't share

Who is providing this notice?	City of Raleigh ECU means City of Raleigh Employees Credit Union.
What We Do	
How does City of Raleigh ECU protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does City of Raleigh ECU collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Open an account ● Apply for a loan ● Give us your contact information ● Give us your wage statements ● Show your driver's license <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness ● affiliates from using your information to market to you ● sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>City of Raleigh ECU has no affiliates.</i>
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>Nonaffiliates we share with can include insurance companies.</i>
Joint Marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>City of Raleigh ECU doesn't jointly market.</i>
