

FACTS	WHAT DOES COLLEGE SAVINGS BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service(s) you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• social security number;</li> <li>• account balances and transaction history;</li> <li>• credit scores and credit history.</li> </ul> When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share consumer personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share consumer personal information, the reasons College Savings Bank chooses to share and whether you can limit this sharing.

<b>For our everyday business purposes</b> – i.e. to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations or report to credit bureaus.	Yes	No

What we do:	
<b>How does College Savings Bank protect my personal information?</b>	To protect your information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We authorize our employees to retrieve your information only when needed to do their work. Vendors working for us are required to protect your information.
<b>How does College Savings Bank collect my personal information?</b>	We collect your personal information when you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• open an account or deposit money;</li> <li>• apply for a loan or provide account information;</li> <li>• or make a withdraw from your account.</li> </ul> We also collect your personal information from others such as, credit bureaus, affiliates or other companies.
<b>Why can't I limit sharing?</b>	Federal law gives you the right to only limit: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness;</li> <li>• affiliates from using your information to market to you;</li> <li>• and sharing for non-affiliates to market to you.</li> </ul> State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
<b>What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?</b>	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
<b>Affiliates</b>	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• College Savings Bank is a privately held company without any affiliates under common ownership or control.</li> </ul>
<b>Non-Affiliates</b>	Companies not related by common ownership or control. The can be financial and non-financial companies.
<b>Joint Marketing</b>	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• College Savings Bank does not jointly market.</li> </ul>
