WHAT DOES COMMUNITY BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal aw also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number
- Checking account information
- Account balances
- Overdraft history
- Payment history
- Credit history

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Community Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Reasons we can share your personal information	Does Community Bank share?	Can you limit this sharing?
For our everyday business purposes— such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No
For our marketing purposes— to offer our products and services to you	No	We do not share

For our affiliates' everyday business purposes— information about your transactions and experiences	No	We do not share
For our affiliates' everyday business purposes— information about your creditworthiness	No	We do not share
For our affiliates to market to you	No	We do not share
For nonaffiliates to market to you	No	We do not share

What we do

How does Community Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, Community Bank maintains physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that comply with federal regulations to guard your nonpublic personal information.
How does Community Bank collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account Use your debit card Make deposits/withdraws from your account Apply for a loan Give us your income information We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness Affiliates from using your information to market to you Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • Community Bank has no affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • Community Bank does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Community Bank does not jointly market.
