Who is providing this notice? Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
	 We do not sell your information to outside marketers to allow them to independently solicit you for a product unless we first ask your permission to send your information. We may disclose customer information about you to credit reporting agencies, in response to a subpoena or court order, as required by certain federal and state laws, to help complete a transaction initiated by you and pursuant to your request or authorization.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
