FACTS	WHAT DOES DULUTH TEACHERS CREDIT UNION (DTCU) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefuly to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we product or service you have with us. This information can include:  Social Security Number Credit card or other debit Credit history Checking account information Account transactions Employment information When you are no longer a member, we may continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share memebers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons DTCU chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does DTCU protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

Why can't I limit all sharing? Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  • DTCU doesn't jointly market			
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.  • DTCU does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.			
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.  • DTCU does not share with our affiliates.
