Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do. This information can include: Social Security number and income Account balances and payment history Credit history and credit score When you are no longer our member, we continue to share your information as described in this notice. How does East Alabama Community Federal Credit Union collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you:  Open and account or deposit money Pay your bills or apply for a loan Use your credit or debit card  We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  • East Alabama Community Federal Credit Union has no affiliates			
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control.  They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  East Alabama Community Federal Credit Union does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you			
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies
