

FACTS WHAT DOES EASTERN NATIONAL BANK, N.A. DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social security number • Payment history • Income • Account balances • Credit history • Checking account information <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
How?	All financial companies need to share customer's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Eastern National Bank, N.A. chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Reasons we can share your personal information	Does Eastern National Bank, N.A. share?	Can you limit this sharing?
For our everyday business purposes – such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or to report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

What we do	
How does Eastern National Bank, N.A. protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Eastern National Bank, N.A. collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open an account • Apply for a loan • Give us your income information • Apply for financing • Provide account information <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives us the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness • affiliates from using your information to market you • sharing for nonaffiliates to market you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related to common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Eastern National Bank, N.A. does not share with affiliates.</i>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related to common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Eastern National Bank, N.A. does not share with nonaffiliated so they can market you.</i>
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Eastern National Bank, N.A. does not jointly market.</i>
