What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: • Social Security number • Credit history • Income • Assets • Transaction or loss history • Employment information When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.		
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Executive National Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What We Do		
How does Executive National Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.	
How does Executive National Bank collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account Make a wire transfer Apply for a loan Show your government-issued ID Make deposits or withdrawals from your account We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies. 	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Affiliates	 Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <i>Executive National Bank has no affiliates.</i> 	
Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <i>Executive National Bank does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i> 	
Joint Marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <i>Executive National Bank doesn't jointly market.</i>
