WHAT DOES FARMERS BANK AND TRUST COMPANY DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

Social Security number
Account balances
Payment history

Checking account information
Wire Transfer instructions

When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Farmers Bank and Trust Company chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

WHAT WE DO	
How does Farmers Bank & Trust Co protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.
How does Farmers Bank & Trust Co collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you -Open an account -Show your government-issued ID -Make a wire transfer -Show your driver's license -Make deposits or withdrawals from your account
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only -Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness -Affiliates from using your information to market to you -Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. DEFINITIONS	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.
	Farmers Bank and Trust Company has no affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. Farmers Bank and Trust Company does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
	Farmers Bank and Trust Company doesn't jointly market.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

For Alaska, Illinois, Maryland and North Dakota Customers. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing- without your authorization.

For California Customers. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing- without your authorization. We will also limit our sharing of personal information about you with our affiliates to comply with all California privacy laws that apply to us.

For Massachusetts, Mississippi, and New Jersey Customers. We will not share personal information from deposit or share relationships with non affiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing- without your authorization.

For Vermont Customers. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing- without your authorization, and we will not share personal information with affiliates about your creditworthiness without your authorization.
