FACTS

What does FIGFCU (Farmers Insurance Group Federal Credit Union) do with your personal information?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and name
- Account balances and transaction or loss history
- Credit history and checking account information

When you are *no longer* our member, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share member's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information, the reasons FIGFCU chooses to share, and whether you can limit this sharing.

| How does FIGFCU protect my personal information? | To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information. | |
| How does FIGFCU collect my personal information? | We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account or apply for a loan Pay your bills or use your credit, debit or ATM Card Make deposits or withdrawals from your account We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus. | |

| Definitions | |

| Affiliates | Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • FIGFCU does not share with our affiliates so they can market to you. |
| Nonaffiliates | Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • FIGFCU does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you. |
| Joint marketing | A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • FIGFCU does not jointly market. |

Other important information

California Privacy Laws: Farmers Insurance Group Federal Credit Union will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing. FIGFCU limits our sharing of personal information about you with our affiliates to comply with all California privacy laws that apply to us. FIGFCU will share personal information about you with our affiliates only based on your authorization.
