	WHAT DOES FARMERS STATE BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

How does Farmers State Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Farmers State Bank collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account Deposit money Pay your bills Use your credit or debit card Pay us by check We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • Farmers State Bank does not share with our affiliates.
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • Farmers State Bank does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Farmers State Bank does not jointly market.
