Facts	WHAT DOES FAYETTE SAVINGS BANK, SSB DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depends on the product or service you have with use. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Social Security Number• Account Balances• Payment History• Credit History• Checking Account Information• Wire Transfer Instructions
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Fayette Savings Bank, ssb chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

<p>How does Fayette Savings Bank, ssb protect my personal information?</p>	<p>To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.</p>
<p>How does Fayette Savings Bank, ssb collect my personal information?</p>	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open an account • Pay your bills • Apply for a loan • Make Deposits or Withdrawals from your account • Show your driver's license <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
<p>Why can't I limit all sharing?</p>	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharing for affiliates everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness • affiliates from using your information to market to you • sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.</p>
Definitions	
<p>Affiliates</p>	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <i>Fayette Savings Bank, ssb has no affiliates</i></p>
<p>Nonaffiliates</p>	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <i>Fayette Savings Bank, ssb does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i></p>
<p>Joint Marketing</p>	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <i>Fayette Savings Bank, ssb doesn't jointly market.</i></p>
