What does Fidelity National Bank do with your personal information?

WHY? Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

WHAT? The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security Number and Credit History
- Payment History and Checking Account Information
- Account Balances and Transaction History

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

HOW? All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons FIDELITY NATIONAL BANK chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who is providing this notice? FIDELITY NATIONAL BANK

How does FIDELITY NATIONAL BANK protect my personal information? To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

Access to your personal information is restricted to those employees needing to know to provide you services and products.

How does FIDELITY BANK collect my personal information? We collect your personal information, for example, when you:

- Open an account or Deposit money
- Apply for a loan or Use your credit or debit card
- Provide account information

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes--information about your creditworthiness.
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for non-affiliates to market to you.

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions

Affiliates - Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. *Fidelity National Bank doesn't share with our affiliates.*

Non-affiliates - Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. *Fidelity National Bank doesn't share with non affiliates.*

Joint Marketing - A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. *Fidelity National Bank doesn't jointly market.*
