S WHAT DOES FIRST COMMUNITY BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

- Social Security Number and Account Balances
- Account Transactions and Credit History
- Credit Scores and Payment History

When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. Why can't I limit all sharing?	<ul> <li>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</li> <li>sharing for affiliates everyday business purposes - information about your credit worthiness</li> <li>affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> </ul> State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies - FIRST COMMUNITY BANK does not share with our affiliates		
Nonaffiilates	iilates Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. - FIRST COMMUNITY BANK does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.		
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. - FIRST COMMUNITY BANK doesn't jointly market.
