| <b>Why?</b>  | Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.   |
| <b>What?</b> | <p>The types of information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. In the course of normal operations, this information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>» Social Security number</li> <li>» Account Balances</li> <li>» Transaction history</li> <li>» Overdraft history</li> <li>» Payment history</li> <li>» Credit history</li> </ul> |
| <b>How?</b>  | All financial companies need to share customers personal information to run their every day business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers personal information; the reasons First Landmark Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.   |

| How does First Landmark Bank protect my personal information? | To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. Your information is restricted to only those employees who need to know to provide products or services to you.  |
| How does First Landmark Bank collect my personal information? | <p>We collect nonpublic personal information about you, for example, when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>» Open an account</li> <li>» Apply for a loan</li> <li>» Make deposits or withdrawals from your account</li> <li>» Show your drivers license</li> <li>» Make a wire transfer</li> </ul> <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates or other companies.</p> |
| Why can't I limit all sharing?                                | <p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>» Sharing for affiliates everyday business purposes-information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>» Affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>» Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you</li> </ul> <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>              |

## Definitions

| <b>Affiliates</b>      | <p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>» <i>First Landmark Bank has no affiliates.</i></li> </ul>  |
| <b>Non-affiliates</b>  | <p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>» <i>First Landmark Bank does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.</i></li> </ul> |
| <b>Joint Marketing</b> | A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  |
