FACTS	What does First National and First National Financial Services do with your personal information?
Why?	Financial institutions choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand that we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depends on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number and income • Account balances and payment history • Credit history and Credit Core When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial institutions need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons First National chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

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What we do	
How does First National protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings including physical electronics and procedural safeguards.
How does First National collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open an account or deposit money • Pay your bills or apply for a loan • Apply for Insurance or Pay Insurance Premium We also collect your personal information from others such as credit bureaus.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your credit worthiness • affiliates from using your information to market to you • sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First National does not share with our affiliates.
Non Affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First National does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between non affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First National does not jointly market.
