What We Do	
How does First National Bank of the Gulf Coast protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We maintain physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect your non-public personal information. We restrict access only to those employees authorized to access customer information for business purposes.
How does First National Bank of the Gulf Coast collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you: Open an account or Apply for a loan Pay your bills or Provide account information Make deposits or withdrawals from your account We also collect your personal information from others such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes— information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices apply to everyone on your account – unless you tell us otherwise.

Definitions	
Affiliates	 Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Our affiliates include TGR Financial, Inc. and First National Title and Closing Services, Inc.
Non-affiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Non-affiliates we can share with include companies such as a financial service provider, mortgage companies, insurance companies, directs marketing companies or non-profit organizations.
Joint marketing	 A formal agreement between First National Bank of the Gulf Coast and non-affiliated financial companies or financial service providers that together market financial products or services to you. In order to meet your financial goals, we may occasionally contact you regarding a product or service. We may contact you directly or enter into a joint marketing agreement with another company who provides services and products on your behalf through the Bank such as investments, mortgages, or credit cards.
