The information can include: Social Security number and payment history Transaction history and income Credit scores and credit history When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.	
How	All financial companies need to share customer's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customer's personal information; the reasons First Financial Northwest chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non financial companies.
	 Our affiliates include companies with a common corporate identity of First Financial Northwest; financial companies such as First Savings Bank Northwest and First Financial Diversified
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
	 First Financial Northwest does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
	First Financial Northwest doesn't jointly market
