## WHAT DOES THE FIRST WESTERN FAMILY OF COMPANIES AND ITS AFFILIATES DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

## Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

### What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- Account balances and payment history
- Credit history and credit scores

#### How?

All financial companies need to share customer's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons First Western chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does First Western protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does First Western collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you  Open an account or apply for a loan Apply for insurance or seek advice about your investments Make deposits or withdrawals from your account We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing? What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  Our affiliates include companies with a First Western name, financial companies such as our bank, mortgage company, insurance companies, and securities brokers.
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  First Western does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  • First Western does not jointly market
