Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non- financial companies. FreedomBank does not share with affiliates.	
Non-Affiliates	Companies NOT related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. FreedomBank does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.	
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include an accidental death/dismemberment insurance company and bill pay vendor.
