FACTS	What does Gateway Community Bank do with your personal information?
Why?	Financial institutions choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand that we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depends on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: • Social Security number and account balances • Income and Payment history • Checking History and Credit Scores When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Gateway Community Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Gateway Community Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Gateway Community Bank collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: Open an account or deposit money Pay your bills or apply for a loan Use your credit or debit card We also collect your personal information from other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only: sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your credit worthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non financial companies. • Gateway Community Bank has no affiliates.
Non Affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • Gateway Community Bank does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between non affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Gateway Community Bank does not share with non affiliates so they can market to you.
