WHAT DOES GEOVISTA FEDERAL CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: - Social Security number and account balances - credit history and employment information - payment history and wire transfer instructions

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons GeoVista Federal Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. - GeoVista Federal Credit Union has no affiliates			
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. - Nonaffiliates we share with can include insurance companies, securities broker-dealers, government agencies, plastic card processors (credit/debit/ATM), financial statement publishers or printers, mailhouse, mortgage companies, mortgage service companies, consumer reporting agencies, data processors, and check/share draft printers			
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. - Our joint marketing partners include advertising/marketing agencies, CUNA Mutual Group's MEMBERCONNECT, and financial advisors
