What We Do		
How does Greater Nevada, LLC protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.	
How does Greater Nevada, LLC collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you Apply for a loan Give us your income information Provide employment information We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies. 	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. 	
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Affiliates	 Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. Our affiliates include: Financial companies such as: Greater Nevada Credit Union 	
Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. Greater Nevada, LLC does not share with nonaffiliates (other than in the context of a joint marketing agreement) so they can market to you. 	
Joint Marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies and financial service providers
