These measures include computer safe- guards, secured files and buildings, procedural safeguards and safe record storage. We will continue to review and modify our security controls in the future to deal with chang- es in products, services and technology.	
How does Harlingen Area Teachers' Credit Union collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you open an account apply for a loan use your credit or debit card pay your bills make deposits to or withdrawals from your accounts We also collect your personal information from others, including credit bureaus or other companies. 	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law only gives you the right to limit only: sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Non-affiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Harlingen Area Teachers' Credit Union <i>does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.</i>
