Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Hopewell Valley Community Bank has no affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Nonaffiliates we share with can include mortgage companies, insurance companies, direct marketing companies, non profit companies, and other companies.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Joint marketing companies we share with may include credit card companies, and other companies
