

**FACTS** **WHAT DOES HORIZON COMMUNITY CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?**

<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
<b>What?</b>	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Social Security number</li> <li>● Account balances</li> <li>● Payment history</li> <li>● Credit history</li> <li>● Credit card or other debt</li> <li>● Mortgage rates and payments</li> </ul>
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons Horizon Community Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

<b>For our everyday business purposes -</b> such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

<b>For our affiliates' everyday business purposes -</b> information about your transactions and experiences	No	We don't share

<b>For our affiliates to market to you</b>	Yes	Yes
<b>For nonaffiliates to market to you</b>	No	We don't share

What We Do	
<b>How does Horizon Community Credit Union protect my personal information?</b>	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.
<b>How does Horizon Community Credit Union collect my personal information?</b>	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Make deposits or withdrawals from your account</li> <li>● Give us your contact information</li> <li>● Give us your income information</li> <li>● Show your driver's license</li> <li>● Provide employment information</li> </ul> We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
<b>Why can't I limit all sharing?</b>	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>● affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>● sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> </ul> State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
<b>What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?</b>	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
<b>Affiliates</b>	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <i>Our affiliates include:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <i>Financial companies such as: Member Financial Services by CUNA.</i></li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Nonaffiliates</b>	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <i>Horizon Community Credit Union does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Joint Marketing</b>	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <i>Horizon Community Credit Union doesn't jointly market.</i></li> </ul>
