Facts What does Inter National Bank ("INB") do with your personal information?	
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number and employment information • account balances and transaction history • credit history and investment experience
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Wells Fargo chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does INB protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does INB collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open an account or deposit money • Pay your bills or apply for a loan • Use your credit or debit card <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness • Affiliates from using your information to market to you • Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more information on your rights under state law.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	<p>Your choice will apply to everyone on your account - unless you tell us otherwise.</p>

Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Affiliates we share information with include Banco Mercantil del Norte and Banorte Securities, Inc.</i>
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>INB does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint Marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Our joint marketing partners include a marketing agency, direct mail company credit and prepaid debit card companies.</i>

Other important information
<p>CA & VT Residents: We will not share your information with nonaffiliates without your consent except for our everyday business purposes and as required or permitted by law.</p> <p>NV Residents: To be placed on our internal Do Not Call list, call 1-877-896-2646.
