Jonah Bank of Wyoming Notice of Privacy Policy

FACTS	WHAT Does Jonah Bank of Wyoming DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal Law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number and income • Credit History and Credit Scores • Account Balances and Payment History When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Jonah Bank of Wyoming chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Jonah Bank of Wyoming protect my personal information?	To protect your information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Jonah Bank of Wyoming collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • open an account or deposit any money • pay your bills or apply for a loan • use your debit card We also collect your personal information from other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your credit worthiness • affiliates from using your information to market you • sharing for nonaffiliates to market you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial or nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Jonah Bank of Wyoming has no affiliates.</i>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Jonah Bank of Wyoming does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Our joint marketing partner includes our credit card processor.</i>
