Affiliates	 Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Lakes Area Federal Credit Union has no affiliates 		
Non-affiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Lakes Area Federal Credit Union does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you. 		
Joint marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Lakes Area Federal Credit Union doesn't jointly market.

Under Minnesota law Lakes Area Federal Credit Union does not share personal information except as allowed by law for everyday business purposes.
