FACTS	WHAT DOES LIBERTY BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your financial information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number and account balances • Credit history and employment information • Payment history and income <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
How?	All financial companies need to share customer's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Liberty Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Liberty Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We further utilize data encryption and secure transmission of information over the Internet as well as anti-virus/malware protection of internal systems.
How does Liberty Bank collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • apply for a loan or open an account • make deposits or withdrawals from your account or pay us by check • provide employment information

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DEFINITIONS

<p>Affiliates</p>	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Liberty Bank has no affiliates.</i>
<p>Nonaffiliates</p>	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Liberty Bank does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>
<p>Joint marketing</p>	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Our joint marketing partners include Financial Services Companies (such as Credit Card or Insurance Companies)</i>
