FACTS	WHAT DOES MATADORS COMMUNITY CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: • Social Security number and income • account balance and payment history • credit history and credit score When you are <i>no longer</i> our member, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share member's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies share their member's personal information; the reasons Matadors Community Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing. If you choose to limit the sharing of your personal information and you have a joint account holder, their information sharing will also be limited.

Who is providing this notice?	Matadors Community Credit Union
What we do	
How does Matadors Community Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Matadors Community Credit Union collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example when you Open an account or apply for a loan Deposit money or use your debit card Pay your bills We also collect information from others such as credit bureaus or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes — information about your creditworthiness Affiliates from using your information to market to you Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • Matadors Community Credit Union does have any affiliates
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non financial companies. • Matadors Community Credit Union does NOT share with non-affiliates so they can market to you
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

Other important information

California law prohibits an institution from sharing with non-affilliated third parties except as necessary for our everyday business purposes or to offer our products and services to you. California law limits an institution from sharing with other financial companies unless you have given us permission. Matadors Community Credit Union does not share information with affiliates or non-affilliates for other than our everyday business purposes or to offer our products and services to you.
