FACTS WHAT DOES MNFCU DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why? Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we

What? The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number
- Payment history
- Transaction history
- Account transactions
- Mortgage rates and payments
- Wire transfer instructions

When you are no longer a member, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How? All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons MNFCU chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does MNFCU protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.

Affiliates Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • MNFCU does not share with our affiliates.	

Non affiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies • MNFCU does not share with non affiliates so they can market to you.

Joint Marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • MNFCU doesn't jointly market.

Other Important Information

For Alaska, Illinois, Maryland and North Dakota Members. We will not share personal information with non affiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization. For California Members. We will not share personal information with non affiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization. We will also limit our sharing of personal information about you with our affiliates to comply with all California privacy laws that apply to us.

For Massachusetts, Mississippi and New Jersey Members. We will not share personal information from deposit or share relationships with non affiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization. For Vermont Members. We will not share personal information with non affiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing without your authorization, and we will not share personal information with affiliates about your creditworthiness without your authorization.
