PRIVACY POLICY NOTICE**

<b>FACTS</b>	<b>WHAT DOES NORTHWOODS COMMUNITY CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?</b>
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<b>Why?</b>	<p>Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.</p> <p>At Northwoods Community Credit Union, we respect the privacy of our members. We recognize the importance of maintaining the confidentiality of your personal financial information. This notice describes the privacy policy and practices followed by Northwoods Community Credit Union. This notice explains what types of member information we collect and under what circumstances we may share it.</p>
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<b>What?</b>	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the accounts or services you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Name, address, and social security number</li> <li>■ Account balances and transaction history</li> <li>■ Credit history and payment scores</li> </ul> <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our member, we will not share your information except as permitted or required by law as described in this notice.</p>
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<b>How?</b>	<p>All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons Northwoods Community Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.</p>
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Reasons we can share your personal information	Does Northwoods Community Credit Union share?	Can you limit this sharing?
<b>For our everyday business purposes—</b> such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No
<b>For our marketing purposes—</b> to offer our products and services to you	Yes	No
<b>For joint marketing with other financial companies</b>	Yes	No
<b>For our affiliates' everyday business purposes—</b> information about your transactions and experiences	No	We do not share
<b>For our affiliates' everyday business purposes—</b> information about your creditworthiness	No	We do not share

Who is providing this notice?	<b>Northwoods Community Credit Union</b>
What we do	
How does Northwoods Community Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also restrict access to nonpublic personal information about you to those employees who have a specific business purpose in utilizing your data.
How does Northwoods Community Credit Union collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ open an account or apply for a loan</li> <li>■ apply for any credit union service</li> <li>■ show us your Driver's license</li> <li>■ use your credit or debit card or pay your bills</li> <li>■ make deposits to or withdrawals from your accounts</li> </ul> <p>We also collect your personal information from others, including credit bureaus or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit sharing?	<p>Federal law only gives you the right to limit information sharing as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>■ affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>■ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> </ul> <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
<b>Affiliates</b>	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ <i>Northwoods Community Credit Union does not have any affiliates.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Non-Affiliates</b>	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ <i>Non-affiliates we share with can include insurance companies.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Joint marketing</b>	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ <i>Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies.</i></li> </ul>
