FACTS	WHAT DOES PARTNER COLORADO CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	<p>The types of personal information that we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social Security number and INCOME</li> <li>• Account balances, payment history, transaction or loss history</li> <li>• Credit history and credit scores</li> </ul> <p>When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
How?	All financial companies need to share member personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons we can share our members' personal information; the reasons Partner Colorado Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit sharing.

What we do	
How does Partner Colorado protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with Federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Partner Colorado collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• open an account, apply for a loan</li> <li>• request wire services, change of address, change of name</li> </ul> We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes-information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>• affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>• sharing for non-affiliates to market to you</li> </ul> State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• First Choice Financial Services (IT Support CUSO)</li> </ul>
Non-Affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Credit Union National Association (CUNA)</li> <li>• Credit Union Service Network (CUSN)</li> </ul>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Allied/ Insurance Companies</li> <li>• CUNA Mutual Group</li> </ul>
