

FACTS	WHAT DOES FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF LE CENTER DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	 The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: Social security number and checking account information Credit history and employment information Income and transaction history
How?	All financial companies need to share customer's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customer's personal information; the reason First National Bank of Le Center choose to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does First National Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

Affiliates	 Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <i>First National Bank of Le Center has no affiliates</i> 	
Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. First National Bank of Le Center does not share with nonaffiliates 	
Joint marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <i>First National Bank of Le Center does NOT jointly market</i>
