Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Plaza Bank does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you. 	
Joint marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include financial service providers such as insurance companies or security broker-dealers that offer joint programs with us, and typically offer financial services that are different from those we provide. Plaza Bank does not have formal agreements will nonaffiliated financial companies to offer joint marketing products.
