WHAT DOES PRAIRIE COMMUNITY BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number
- Account balances
- Transaction history
- Credit history
- Overdraft history
- Checking account information

When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Prairie Community Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Prairie Community Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Prairie Community Bank collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account Apply for a loan Use your credit or debit card Provide your mortgage information Make a wire transfer We also collect your personal information from other companies.
Why can't I limit all	Federal law gives you the right to limit only
