

FACTS**WHAT DOES SECURITY NATIONAL CORPORATION AND ITS AFFILIATED BANKS DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?****Why?**

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security Number and checking account information
- account balances and transaction history
- payment history and credit history

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in the notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Security National Corporation and its Affiliated Banks choose to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do

How does Security National Corporation and its Affiliated Banks protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does Security National Corporation and its Affiliated Banks collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- open an account or give us your contact information
- apply for a loan or show your government-issued ID
- tell us about your investment or retirement portfolio

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Our affiliates include financial companies owned by Security National Corporation*

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Security National Corporation and its Affiliated Banks do not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.*

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *Security National Corporation and its Affiliated Banks do not jointly market.*
