FACTS	WHAT DOES State Bank of New Prague DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: § Social Security number and overdraft history § Credit History and transaction or loss history § Account balances and account transactions When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share customer and personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reason financial companies can share their customer personal information; the reasons State Bank of New Prague chooses to share; and whether

you can limit this sharing.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. § State Bank of New Prague does not share with our affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. § State Bank of New Prague does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or service to you. § State Bank of New Prague does not jointly market
