This is our privacy notice for our customers who have the right to know the privacy policies and practices of this financial institution as they relate to the collection and disclosure of information with both affiliated and nonaffiliated parties. In order to provide the proper disclosure information, the following definitions are offered as they relate to financial privacy rights.

FACTS

WHAT DOES SWISHER TRUST & SAVINGS BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

I Social Security number I Transaction history
I Account balances I Overdraft history

I Payment history I Checking account information
When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Swisher Trust & Savings Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Joint Marketing

## Other Important Information

For Alaska, Illinois, Maryland and North Dakota Customers. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization.

For California Customers. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you

or for joint marketing - without your authorization. We will also limit our sharing of personal information about you with our affiliates to comply with all California privacy laws that apply to us.

For Massachusetts, Mississippi and New Jersey Customers. We will not share personal information from deposit or share relationships with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization.

For Vermont Customers. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or

for joint marketing - without your authorization, and we will not share personal information with affiliates about your creditworthiness without your authorization.
