#### What does Texas Heritage National Bank do with your personal information?

##### Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

##### What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- Account balances and payment history
- Credit history and account balances

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

##### How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons **Texas Heritage National Bank** chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do

**How does Texas Heritage National Bank protect my personal information?**

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

**How does Texas Heritage National Bank collect my personal information?**

We collect your personal information, for example, when you:

- Open an account or apply for a loan
- Show your driver's license or provide employment information
- Make deposits or withdrawals from your account

We also collect your personal information from other companies.

**Why can't I limit all sharing?**

Federal law gives you the right to limit only:

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for non-affiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.

Definitions

**Affiliates**

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non financial companies.

- **Texas Heritage National Bank** does not share with our affiliates.

**Non Affiliates**

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.

- **Texas Heritage National Bank** does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.

**Joint Marketing**

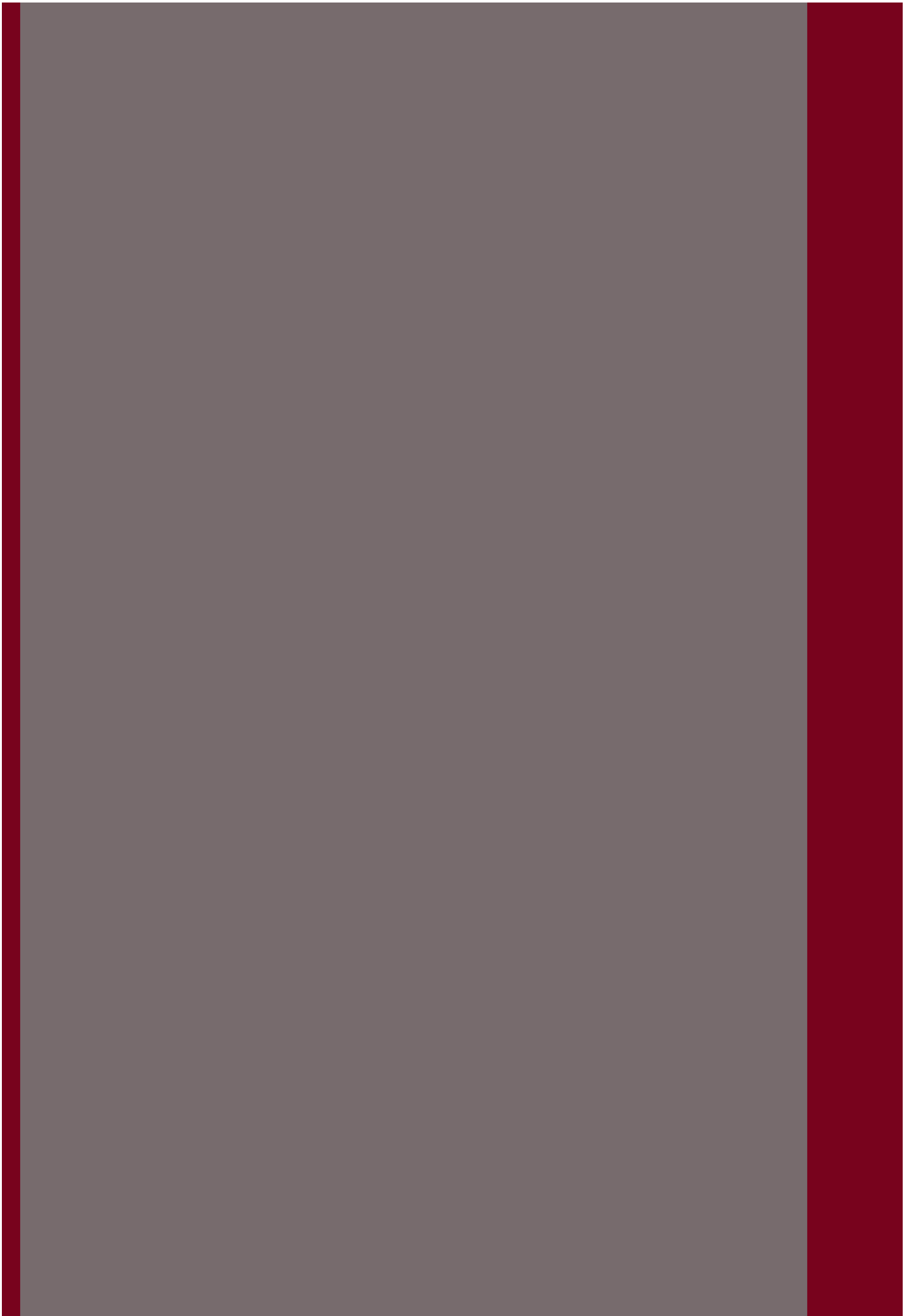
A formal agreement between non affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

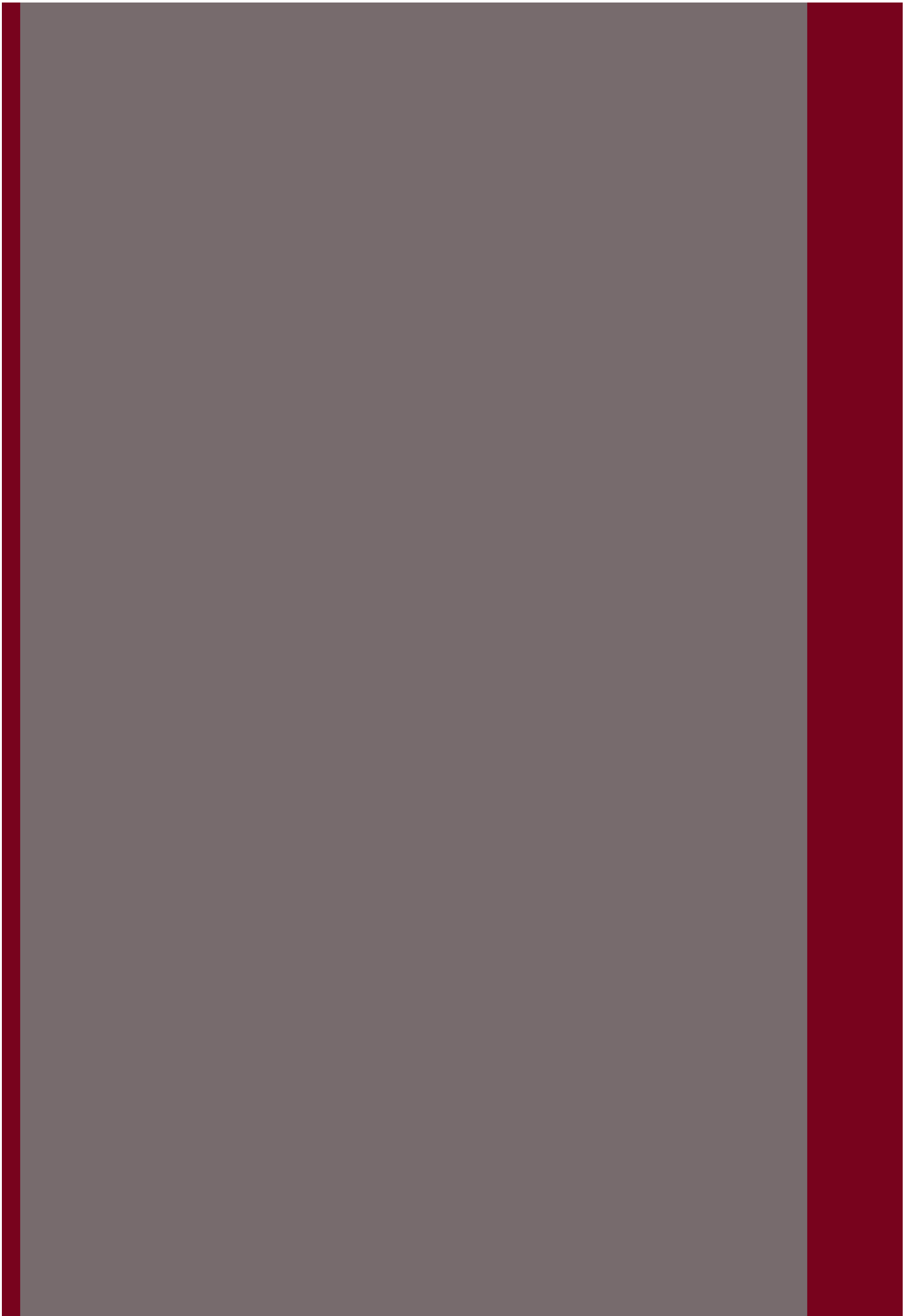

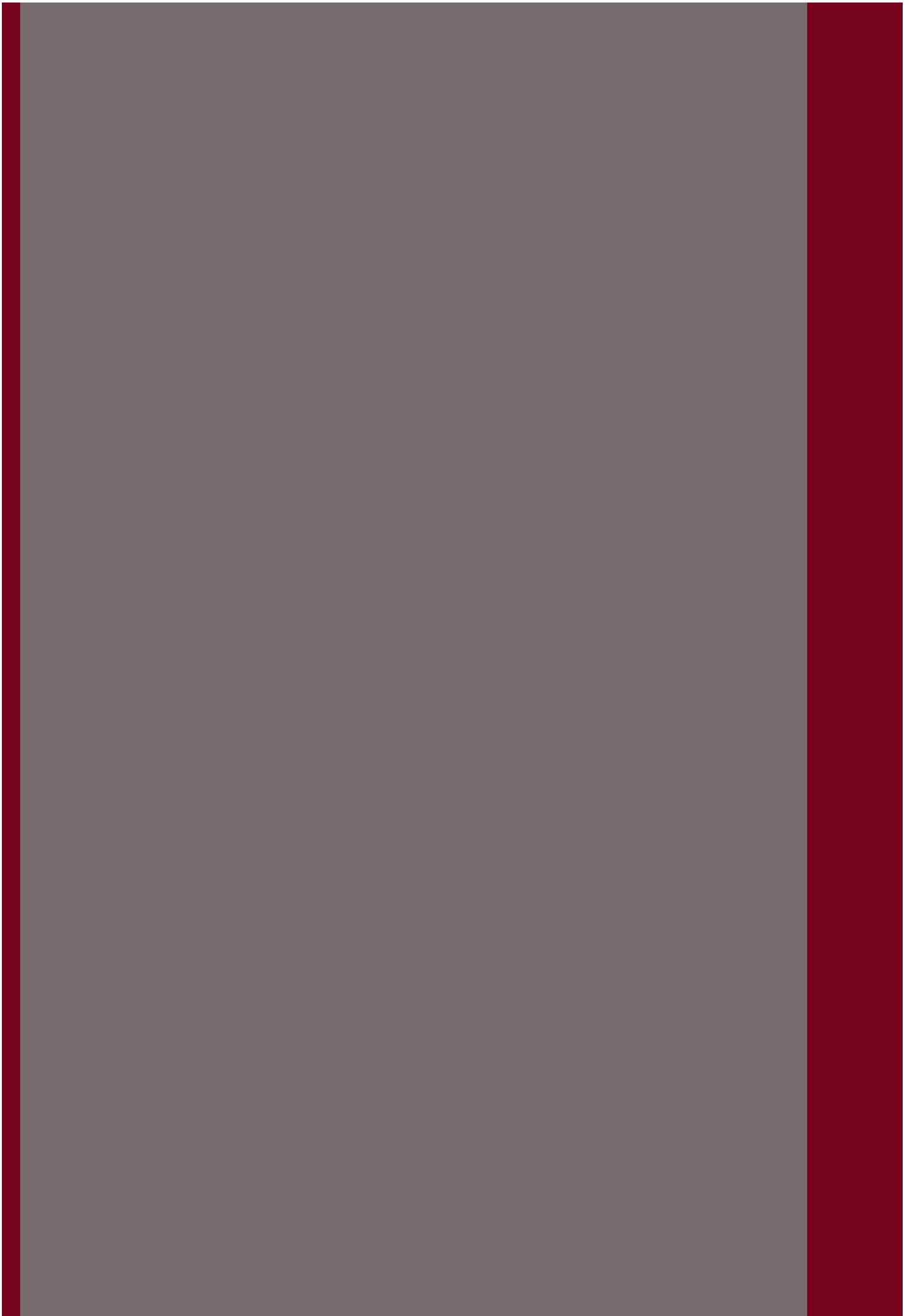
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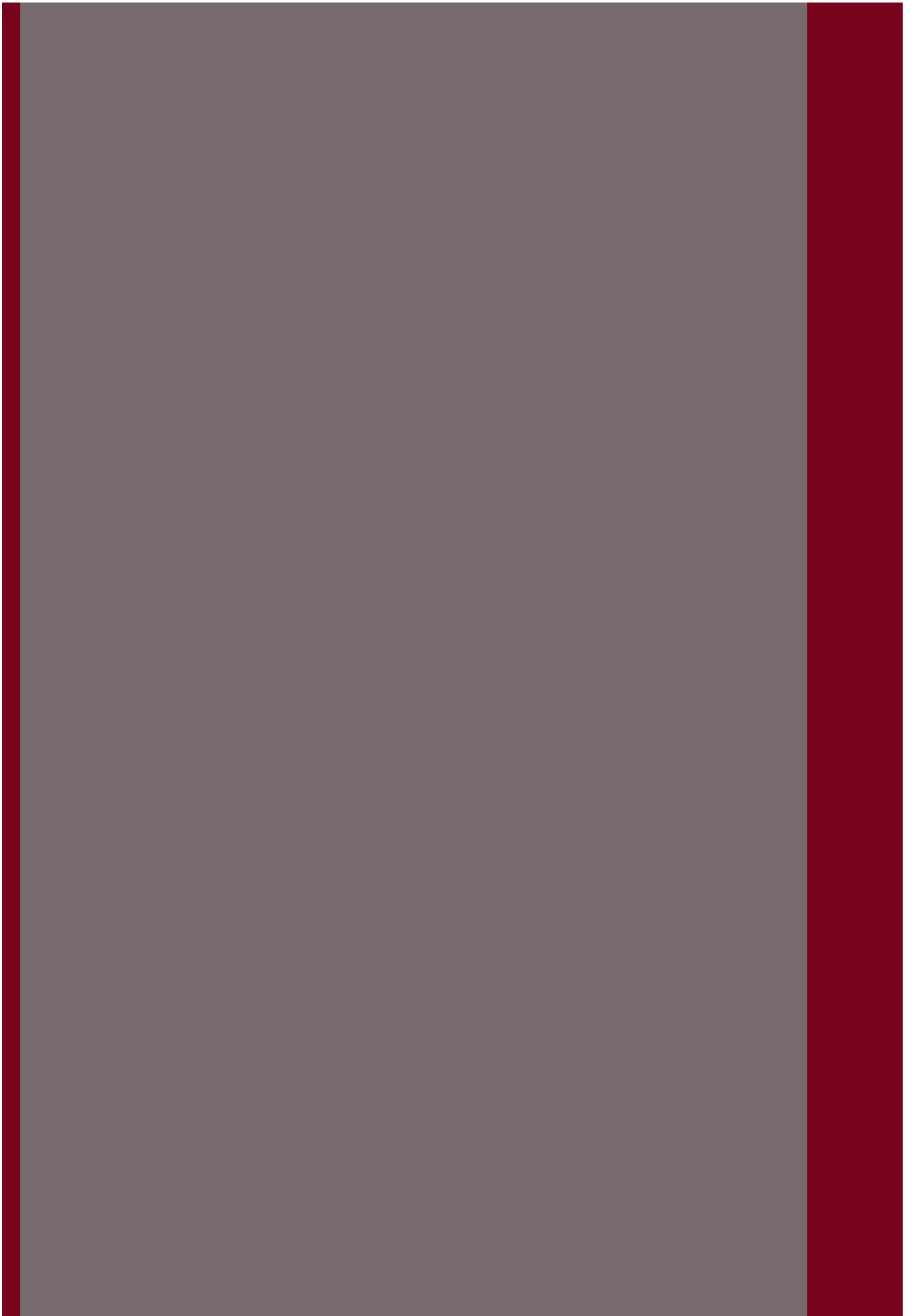
**Notice of changes in temporary FDIC insurance coverage for transaction accounts:** By operations of federal law, beginning January 1, 2013, funds deposited in a non-interest bearing transaction account (including an Interest on Lawyer Trust Account) no longer will receive unlimited deposit insurance coverage by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC). Beginning January 1, 2013, all of a depositor's accounts at an insured depository institution, including all non-interest-bearing transaction accounts, will be insured by the FDIC up to the standard maximum deposit insurance amount (\$250,000.00), for each deposit insurance ownership category. 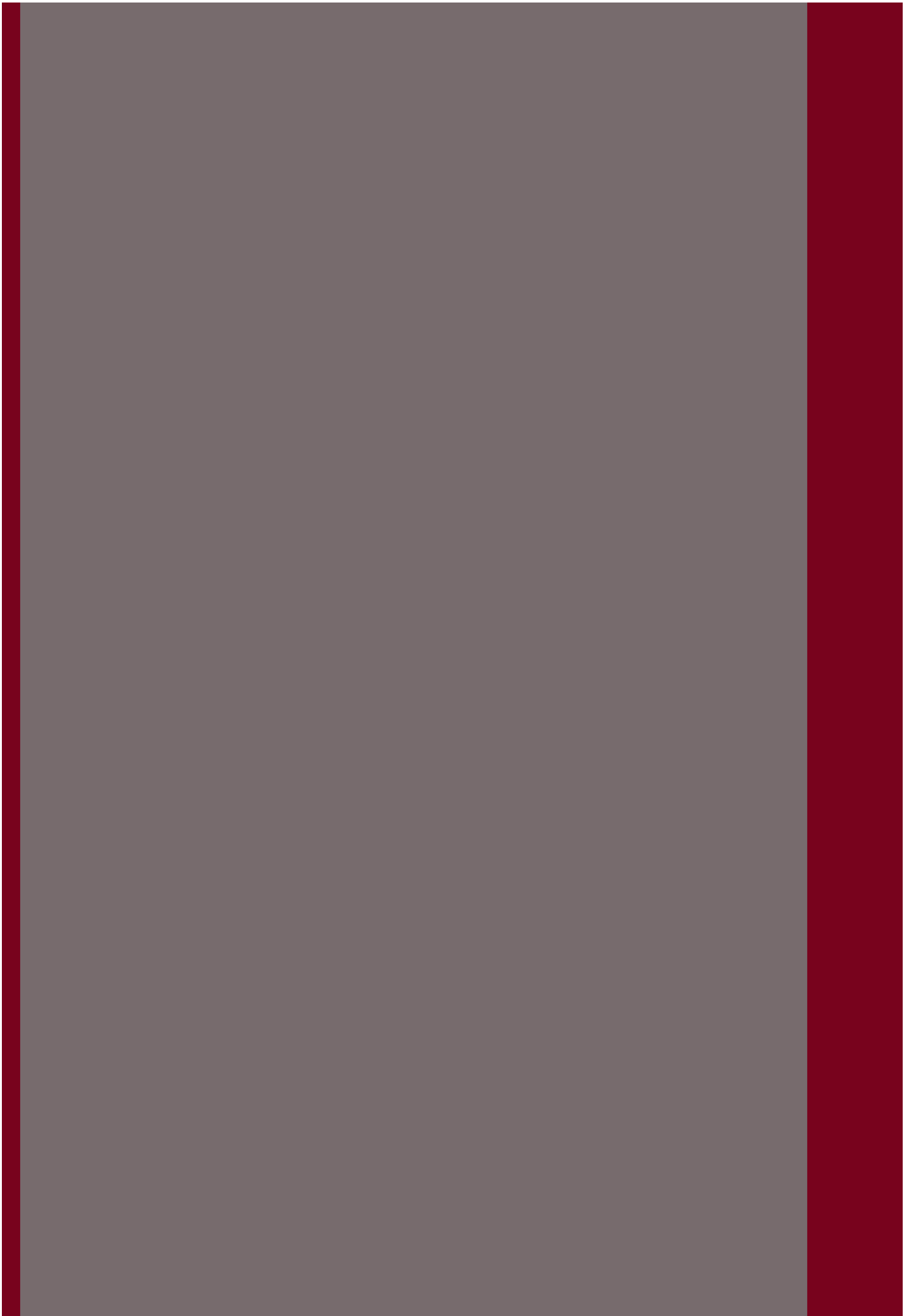


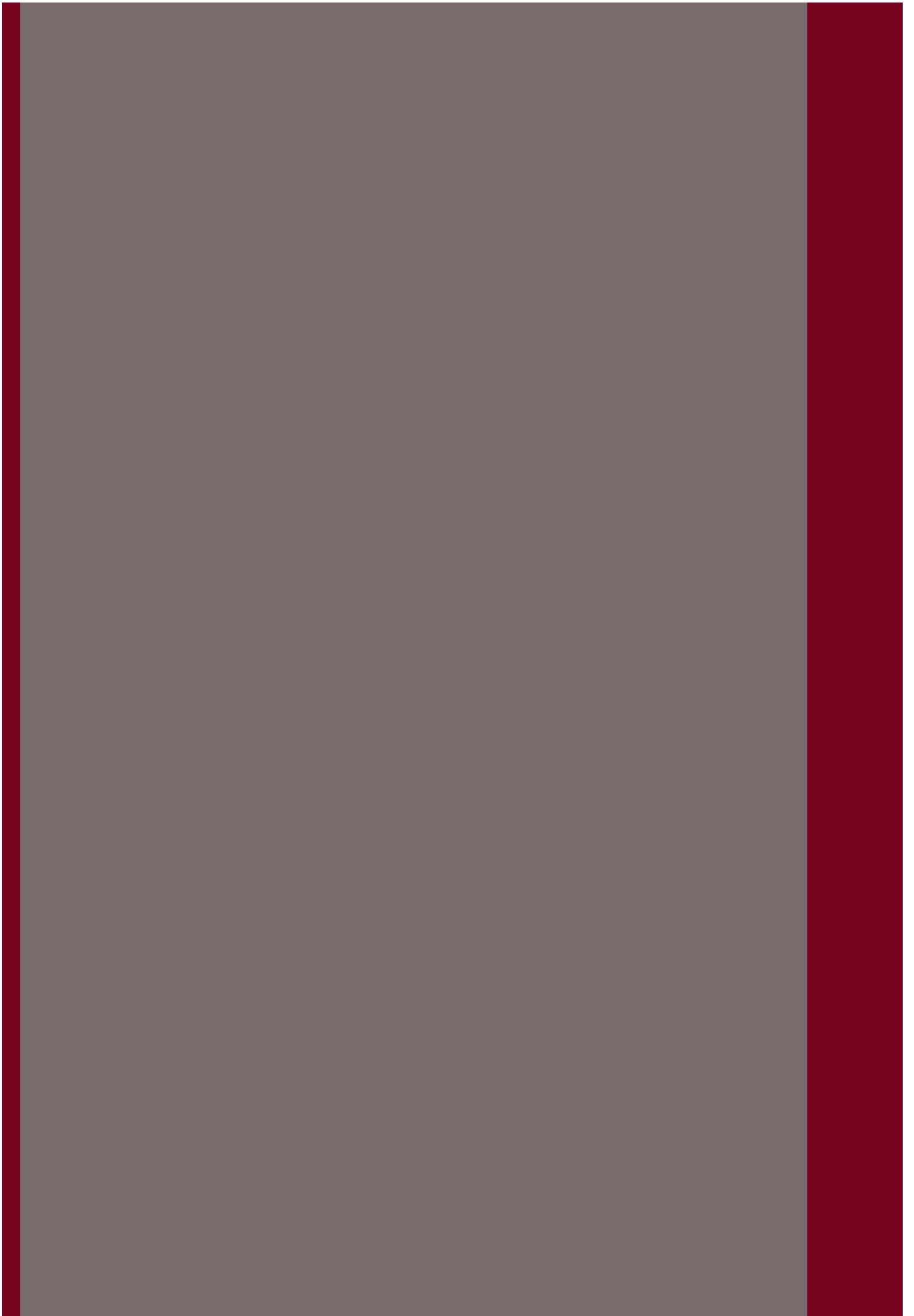
