FACTS	WHAT DOES THE CITIZENS BANK OF FORSYTH COUNTY DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?		
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.		
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What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: Social Security number and income Account balances and payment history Credit history and credit scores When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.		
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Bank of Bourbonnais chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does The Citizens Bank of Forsyth County protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

Why can't I limit all sharing? Definitions				
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. The Citizens Bank of Forsyth County has no affiliates			
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. The Citizens Bank of Forsyth County does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you			
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. The Citizens Bank of Forsyth County doesn't jointly market
