Affiliates	 Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies Our affiliates include financial companies such as CSB Mortgage Company, Inc. 		
Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. The Cortland Savings and Banking Company does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market together. 		
Joint marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include companies such as securities broker/dealers.
