What We Do	
How does TAB Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • Our affiliates include: • Others, such as: FJ Management Inc. and its affiliates including, but not limited to financial companies, insurance companies, hospitality companies and oil companies.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • Nonaffiliates we share with can include other financial service companies, insurance companies and direct marketing companies or providers of products or services that may be of interest to our customers.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Our joint marketing partners include other financial service companies, insurance companies and direct marketing companies or providers of products or services that may be of interest to our customers.

Other Important Information

For Alaska, Illinois, Maryland and North Dakota Customers. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization.

For California Customers. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization. We will also limit our sharing of personal information about you with our affiliates to comply with all California privacy laws that apply to us.

For Massachusetts, Mississippi and New Jersey Customers. We will not share personal information from deposit or share relationships with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization.

For Vermont Customers. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates for them to market to you without your authorization and we will not share personal information with affiliates or for joint marketing about your creditworthiness without your authorization.
